
To collect SMS messages (including WhatsApp and Facebook messages), we rely on the generosity of the British public to provide us with their messages to incorporate into the corpus. We are asking the public to provide us with copies of any messages sent between 2014 and 2018. Messages should be unedited, but you are welcome to anonymise them. We will carry out our own anonymization procedures, but if you would like to remove any personal information yourself, please replace it with [anon] before submission.

**Note:** SMS messages should be written by British native speakers, people who grew up in the UK and use English as their first language, and unedited.


# To submit Facebook messages:

Step 1: Open the Google Chrome web browser.

**Step 2:** Click the three vertical dots in the task bar > More Tools > Extensions.



Step 3: Search for Message/Chat Downloader and click "+ ADD TO CHROME".










**Step 4:** Log into Facebook, go to your messages in the full messenger window (by selecting "See all in Messenger"). Select the conversation you want to download.



**Step 5:** Press the new messenger icon (placed there by the extension) in the address bar.










**Step 6:** Select the date range you want and click "Start download". When the download is complete, the page will be updated to only show your selected conversation.



**Step 7:** Hold down Ctrl + A to select all, then copy the text into a .txt file.



**Step 8:** You are welcome to anonymise the data by replacing any names or personal information with **[anon]**. We will carry out our own anonymization procedures and automatically remove the timestamp and user ID, but if you would like to remove personal information yourself, we would recommend sifting through your messages to ensure you are happy for everything to be included in the corpus.
